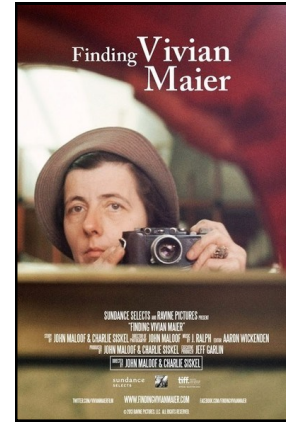
The City of the Dead in the City of the Living
